# Basic level coronavirus restrictions in Pyhäjoki from 04/06/2021 onward

#### On 01/06/2021, the Regional State Administration Agency has issued a decision under Section 58 of the Infectious Diseases Act for the regions of Northern Ostrobothnia and Kainuu from 01./06/2021onwards (see decision).

In its meeting on 01/06/2021, the regional coordination group has outlined the recommendations and restrictions that shall apply until 23/5/2021 (see recommendations and restrictions).

During its meeting on 04/06/2021, the Crisis Management Team of the Municipality of Pyhäjoki has decided on the restrictions in Pyhäjoki from 04/06/2021 onward.

## Coronavirus measures in Pyhäjoki Municipality from 04/06/2021 onward

#### Extended remote work recommendation

It is recommended that all employees work remotely if it is possible in terms of work performance.

#### **Remote meeting practices**

Remote meeting practices shall be continued both at workplaces and in case of leisure time meetings.

#### Mask recommendations

In principle, the mask recommendations apply to over 12-yearolds. In addition to this, a recommendation to use a mask has been issued for grades 6-9 of Saari Lower Secondary School.

A mask must be used:

- in public indoor spaces and at public events
- in public transport and other public modes of transport
- indoors at workplaces, if wearing a mask is possible.
- individuals travelling to provide a sample for a coronavirus test and before receiving the test results, if it is essential to travel outside the home.
- individuals arriving to Finland from a risk area, when they are travelling from the point of entry into the country to the voluntary quarantine location, or if they have an essential reason to travel outside the home during the voluntary quarantine
- healthcare staff in all patient work, if the safety distances are not met
- the recommendation also applies to patients, relatives,



students, and visitors.

• in the premises of private service providers (shops, banks, pharmacies, etc.)

#### Public events

There is no limit to the number of participants of indoor and outdoor public events in accordance with the Regional State Administration Agency's decision from 01/06/2021 onward.

## Private events

It is recommended that the size of private events is kept as moderate as possible and the safety instructions are followed.

## Risk groups

- It is recommended to carefully consider visiting the elderly and members of the risk groups. Using the mask and good hand hygiene are recommended.
- In case of visits, the Finnish Institute for Health and Welfare's "Visitations to long-term treatment and care operating units during the coronavirus epidemic" guidelines are observed (see the Finnish Institute for Health and Welfare's guidelines)

## Coronavirus test

In case of respiratory symptoms, such as cough, throat ache, cold or breathing difficulties, please seek medical advice and be tested at a low threshold.
